La Bella Vita

We are well on are way with the construction of the first building of Bungalow Apartments. Later this month we will be starting the third and final floor. All of the concrete work will be completed soon. We expect the entire building to be completed in the spring of 2009.

A new sign has been installed along the Carboca highway turnoff, you can not miss it! New Directional signs will lead guests and visitors directly to Playa La Jolla. The main highway sign will also be lit at night.

The current phase of development includes 24 Bungalow Style Walk Up Apartments and 8 Three Storey Townhouse Villas. Pre-sales have been going well. To date 50% of the Bungalow Apartments have been pre-sold and there are several reservations on the Townhouse Villas. to Northwest Mexico will be greatly improved. This may very well be the final push for Sonoara to be recognized as a world class tourist destination.

Part of the first stage includes the 134 km. stretch from the Gulf of Santa Clara to Puerto Penasco. According to authorities at the Department of Communications and Transportation 70% of this stage is complete. This stretch will be finished late 2008 or early 2009. Once finished the drive from San Diego will be less than 5 hours.
